BHEL SCHOLARSHIP SCHEME--II

1. OBJECTIVE OF THE SCHEME

To widen and spread the reach of quality professional education to economically weaker sections of the society in Bhopal .

2. NUMBER OF SCHOLARSHIPS

The number of scholarships in various disciplines of Engineering/Medical field will be decided by the BHEL management from time to time. For the year 2009-10 the number of scholarships shall be restricted to 14(fourteen) out of which 12 shall be for Engg. and 02 shall be for MBBS. These numbers may vary/change without any prior notice.

3. COURSE, DISCIPLINE AND INSTITUTION

BHEL scholarship shall be awarded to the students pursuing full time degree course in **Engineering and MBBS** in any of the institutions recognized by the AICTE/ Central Government/ Association of Indian Universities

4. VALUE AND DURATION OF SCHOLARSHIP

The amount of **scholarship** is **Rs. 2000/-** per month. The **scholarship** shall be paid w.e.f. the beginning of Academic session for the entire period of the course. Evaluation of the Scholarship shall be done by the Scholarship Committee of BHEL once in a financial year. Only after such evaluation the scholarship shall be continued for the next financial year. In case the progress of student is not found satisfactory the scholarship may be discontinued.

5. CONDITIONS FOR AWARD OF SCHOLARSHIP

- 5.1 Candidates should be in the First Year of full time degree course in Engineering/ MBBS
- 5.2 Candidate as well as Parents should belong to Madhya Pradesh. Preference shall be given to residents of Bhopal
- 5.3 Total Income of the family of the candidate should not exceed Rs.3,00,000/- (Rs. Three Lakhs Only) per Annum

- 5.4 Preference shall be given to the wards of deceased employees of BHEL.
- 5.5 The scheme is targeted at students joining Engg./Medical degree course in the academic year 2009-10. However in exceptional cases wards of widows in 2nd yr. /onwards of the course, may be considered. Applications from such students shall be considered only when he/she has lost his father after commencement of the course
- 5.6 Preference may also be given to Physically Challenged/ Disabled Students
- 5.7 The candidate should not be in any kind of Employment.
- 5.8 The scholarship shall be reviewed every year and will be renewed every year till the completion of the course. The renewal/continuation of the scholarship will depend on the evaluation of the scholarship committee and promotion to next class or semester provided he/she secures minimum 50% marks in aggregate in semester/annual examination which determines his/her promotion to next class. A scholar dropped in a semester or failing in any subject of a semester shall be disqualified.
- 5.9 For renewal of scholarship the Scholar will send a request letter within 15 days after the announcement of the result giving details of his/her academic achievements in the last academic year and a letter of recommendation from Head of the Institute.
- 5.10 The course must be full time degree course and should be recognized by AICTE/ Central Government/ Association of Indian Universities
- 5.11 Any student/candidate having any criminal record or who has been rusticated from college shall be disqualified.
- 5.12 Any student/candidate receiving any kind of financial grant/scholarship from any other source shall not be considered.

6. PROCEDURE FOR AWARD OF SCHOLARSHIP

The award of Scholarship and continuance thereof will be regulated as under :

- 6.1 Students will be selected after they apply against a press advertisement / notification announcing the availability of BHEL scholarships.

- 6.2 Selection will be made on the basis of Annual Income of the applicant's Family, Financial Background of the family (property, etc.) and academic performance in Matric and Intermediate examinations and also in Engineering/Medical college entrance tests (AIEEE, PET, PMT, etc). Any other criteria may be taken up on recommendation of BHEL Scholarship Committee members.
- 6.3 The applications should be duly recommended by the concerned Institution / College with a suitable endorsement as prescribed in the application form enclosed. Maximum of five applications may be forwarded by each Institution.
- 6.4 Physically challenged students disability certificate issued by Appropriate authority must be enclosed.
- 6.3 The decision of the Company with regard to award of Scholarship, continuance and/or discontinuance as the case may be, shall be final and binding.
- 6.4 The candidate should have a Single Saving Bank account in any of the Nationalized Banks having ECS facility

7. **COMMENCEMENT OF THE SCHEME**

BHEL Scholarship Scheme – II will commence from the academic year 2009-10.

8. **MODE OF PAYMENT**

Payment of BHEL Scholarship may be made to the selected candidates through Account Payee cheques or through ECS facility. Payment may also be made through the concerned authority of the Institution in a manner as decided by the BHEL Management, in consultation with Institution concerned.

9. **GENERAL**

- 9.1 BHEL reserves the right to alter, modify or withdraw the scheme as considered necessary.
- 9.2 The award under BHEL's scholarship Scheme does not, in any manner, guarantee any kind of employment with BHEL.
- 9.3 It is essential that the candidate fills all the information in the application form correctly and truthfully. If at any stage it is found that the student had made false declaration/statement then BHEL shall have full discretion to stop the scholarship.
